On Monday, the world commemorated the strength, courage and resilience of millions of refugees. Nearly 65 million people are displaced worldwide. Each day thousands more flee their homes in search of safety, equity and fair treatment.

NZs refugee quota is 750 per year. This number is relatively small in comparison with the numbers of refugees being supported by other countries of the world. The students in Years 7 and 8 have been exploring this global issue through their studies this week.

Donations for the Social – students in each class are being asked to donate the following goods next week. 1 item per student would be greatly appreciated:

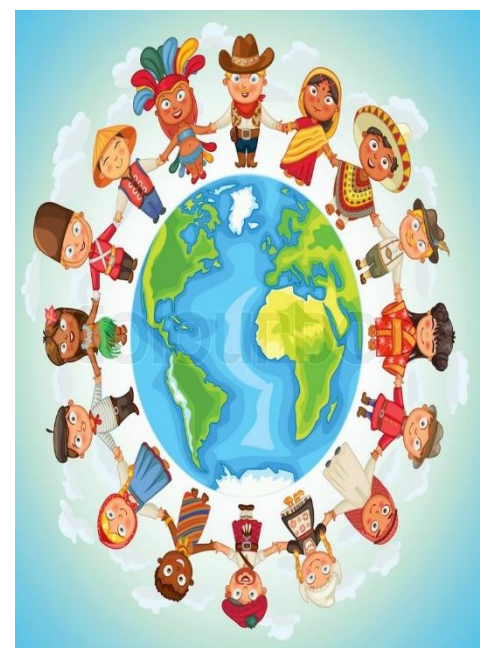
