COMMUNICATION CHAIN

At CTK we to make it easy for you to get in touch with any concerns or questions you might have.

We understand the importance of a strong working relationship between parents and staff in supporting all of our children in their learning.

It is of paramount concern that all children are happy and safe. If you have any concerns about your child's safety or wellbeing, please speak with your child's teacher in the first instance or arrange a meeting time with the Principal.

The School Office:

The majority of queries you may have, which are not answered on our website, are best dealt with by the school office in person, by telephone on 09 626 7123, or by email at admin@ctk.school.nz

This may include questions about updating contact details, reporting absences, purchasing uniforms or payment of school fess.

Class Teacher:

You should approach your child's class teacher, in person where possible, in the first instance, to discuss:

- * Home learning.
- * Social, academic, and personal progress.
- * Classroom and playtime incidents.
- * Organisational issues, e.g. lost property which is not in the Lost Property area.
- * Arrangements for end of day pick-ups and appointments.

School Principal:

To discuss unresolved issues after speaking to the class teacher or to report cases of bullying, you should contact Tracey Kopua directly on 09 626 7123 ext. 720 or via email principal@ctk.school.nz

Times when you will be contacted include:

- If your child is unwell and would benefit from being sent home
- If your child comes to school with a contagious illness; eg. vomiting; diarrhoea; chicken pox; high fever; school sores etc.
- If your child wilfully damages property
- If your child causes harm to another student (physical and/or emotional)
