ACHIEVEMENT AIMS

4. The various ways Jesus Christ the Risen Lord, is present today in the world and in the Church especially in the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
5. Jesus’ mission as Saviour and Redeemer.
6. That Scripture shows that Jesus, God’s son, reveals to the world that God is *Abba* – loving Father - *Matua*
